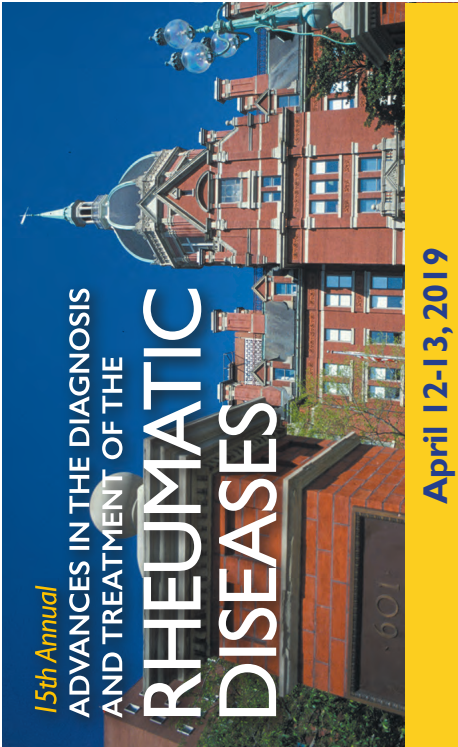

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DESCRIPTION

Now in its 15th year, this two-day symposium has been planned for the providers who care for patients with a rheumatic disease. Given the wide variety of rheumatologic disorders, and an ever-increasing number of diagnostic procedures and treatment options, it is necessary to provide clinicians with information about strategies for the early diagnosis of these conditions, novel state-of-the-art diagnostic tools, and opportunities to utilize the most effective treatments to ensure optimal patient outcomes.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This activity is intended for rheumatologists, internists, gerontologists, orthopedic surgeons, nurses, physician assistants and other allied health professionals involved in the care of patients with rheumatic diseases.
